Guidelines for WALLCOVERINGS

INSPECT YOUR ORDER

- Please inspect all wallcoverings promptly and carefully **BEFORE cutting**.
- Although stock has been thoroughly inspected before shipping, the **FINAL RESPONSIBILITY RESTS WITH THE CUSTOMER**.
- No returns will be accepted on orders that have already been cut.
- Any returns must be authorized by Peter Fasano Ltd prior to shipping.
- **No claims for labor charges will be accepted** by Peter Fasano Ltd.

WALL PREPARATION

- Remove any traces of dirt, old wallpaper or flaking paint.
- Surfaces should be dry, sanded smooth and wiped clean.
- Wallcoverings should **NOT** be applied to walls painted with latex, semi-gloss or enamel paint.
- For best results, we recommend using a lining paper.

ADHESIVE

- The type of adhesive used will depend on the surface being covered and the paper being applied. As a rule of thumb, we recommend using a high quality pre-mixed vinyl adhesive, or a high-quality cellulose paste. Paper hangers will ultimately need to make this decision.
- It is **EXTREMELY IMPORTANT** that any excess adhesive from the surface of the wallcovering be carefully sponged off with clean water **BEFORE** it is allowed to dry.

SEAMING

- All our papers require trimming, typically to 26".
- Pre trim paper on a cutting table using a straight edge, following the printed trim marks where available.
- On papers without printed trim marks, trim 1-1 ½" from each edge of the paper.
- **WE DO NOT RECOMMEND DOUBLE CUTTING** paper on the wall to remove selvages.
